- 1. Gary Moore, Chairman, called the meeting to order.
- 2. Public Comment none
- 3. Old Business
 - a. Evan Hammond moved to accept the March 11, 2016 minutes as printed, second by Mike Misslin. Motion passed.
 - b. NH: Robert Grimley is waiting on response from Governor's office. His term has expired. MA: Undersecretary is "working on it." Carlo Basile is appointment secretary; Mike gave him a name to be appointed. Now they are working with the Corps of Engineers on a study (in September) of Ball Mountain and Townshend Dams ramifications. Mike suggests engineers may need to come up to study and suggest alternatives to bottom release, which sends sediment downstream. Carl Gustafson and Mike will assemble language re: scope of study and suggestions for Tim to take to legislators. Tim is staying in touch with Townshend select board but most action is taking place at governmental level now.
