- 2. Public Comment Denise thanked the Army Corps hosts. Provided some background on the Commission. Commissioners introduced themselves.

Fitzgerald Environmental Associate requested this to provide them the winter months to do the quality control work and final report rather than during the fall field season. We have requested a copy of the final report. Commission provided a background on this issue. Angela will send copy of contract.
